- 2 relating to the accumulation and payment of sick leave for

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 158, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 158.0365 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 158.0365. ACCUMULATION AND PAYMENT OF SICK LEAVE. (a)
- 8 An employee may accumulate sick leave without limit and may use the
- 9 <u>leave if the employee is unable to work because of a bona fide</u>
- 10 illness.
- 11 (b) An employee who leaves the classified service for any
- 12 reason is entitled to receive in a lump-sum payment the full amount
- 13 of the employee's salary for accumulated sick leave if the employee
- 14 has accumulated not more than 720 hours of sick leave. If an
- 15 employee has accumulated more than 720 hours of sick leave, the
- 16 employer may limit payment to the amount that the employee would
- 17 have received if the employee had been allowed to use 720 hours of
- 18 <u>accumulated sick leave during the last six months of the employee's</u>
- 19 employment. The lump-sum payment is computed by compensating the
- 20 employee for the accumulated time at the highest permanent pay
- 21 classification for which the employee was eligible during the last
- 22 six months of the employee's employment. The employer shall pay the
- 23 employee for the same period for which the employee would have been
- 24 paid if the employee had taken sick leave, other than for additional

- 1 holidays, sick leave, or vacation time that the employee would have
- 2 accrued during the 720 hours.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
