- 3 vehicle retail installment transaction.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 348.006(a) and (c), Finance Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The principal balance under a retail installment
- 8 contract is computed by:
- 9 (1) adding:
- 10 (A) the cash price of the motor vehicle;
- 11 (B) each amount included in the retail
- 12 installment contract for an itemized charge; and
- 13 (C) subject to Subsection (c), a documentary fee
- 14 for services rendered for or on behalf of the retail buyer in
- 15 [preparing,] handling[,] and processing documents relating to the
- 16 motor vehicle [and to the closing of the retail installment
- 17 transaction]; and
- 18 (2) subtracting from the results under Subdivision (1)
- 19 the amount of the retail buyer's down payment in money, goods, or
- 20 both.

- 21 (c) For a documentary fee to be included in the principal
- 22 balance of a retail installment contract:
- 23 (1) the retail seller must charge the documentary fee
- 24 to cash buyers and credit buyers;

- 1 (2) the documentary fee may not exceed $\frac{$100}{$}$ [\$50] for a
- 2 motor vehicle retail installment contract or a reasonable amount
- 3 agreed to by the retail seller and retail buyer for a heavy
- 4 commercial vehicle retail installment contract; and
- 5 (3) the buyer's order and the retail installment
- 6 contract must include:
- 7 (A) a statement of the amount of the documentary
- 8 fee; and
- 9 (B) in reasonable proximity to the place in each
- 10 where the amount of the documentary fee is disclosed, the following
- 11 notice in type that is bold-faced, capitalized, underlined, or
- 12 otherwise conspicuously set out from surrounding written material:
- "A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT AN OFFICIAL FEE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE
- 14 IS NOT REQUIRED BY LAW, BUT MAY BE CHARGED TO BUYERS FOR HANDLING
- 15 DOCUMENTS [AND PERFORMING SERVICES] RELATING TO [THE CLOSING OF] A
- 16 SALE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE MAY NOT EXCEED \$100 [\$50] FOR A MOTOR
- 17 VEHICLE CONTRACT OR A REASONABLE AMOUNT AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES FOR
- 18 A HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLE CONTRACT. THIS NOTICE IS REQUIRED BY
- 19 LAW."
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
