- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 371.005, Finance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 371.005. REGULATORY AND ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY. (a)
- 8 The legislature has exclusive authority regarding the operation of
- 9 pawnshops, except for a matter delegated by this chapter to the
- 10 commissioner or except as provided by Subsection (b). The
- 11 commissioner has the authority to regulate only a business practice
- 12 that requires a pawnshop license.
- 13 (b) The governing body of a municipality may adopt an
- 14 ordinance to enforce a provision of this chapter, other than a
- 15 provision relating to licensing, against an individual who holds a
- 16 pawnshop license issued by this state or an employee of a person who
- 17 <u>holds a pawnshop license issued by this state. An ordinance adopted</u>
- 18 under this subsection may not provide a penalty greater than a Class
- 19 C misdemeanor.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
