- 2 relating to telephone or electronic mail notification to a
- 3 respondent of a complaint filed with the Texas Ethics Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 571.123(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) After a complaint is filed, the commission shall
- 8 immediately attempt to contact and notify the respondent of the
- 9 complaint by telephone or electronic mail. If the commission fails
- 10 to contact the respondent by telephone or electronic mail, the
- 11 <u>commission shall send written notice to the respondent.</u> Not later
- 12 than the fifth business day after the date a complaint is filed, the
- 13 commission shall send written notice to the complainant and, unless
- 14 it has previously done so, to the respondent. The written notice to
- 15 the complainant and the respondent must:
- 16 (1) state whether the complaint complies with the form
- 17 requirements of Section 571.122; and
- 18 (2) if applicable, include the information required by
- 19 Section 571.124(e).
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
