9	place and date of birth by obtaining a declaration of origin from a
10	court as provided by this chapter.
11	(b) An order by a court under this chapter establishing an
12	individual's place and date of birth establishes the individual's
13	identity for purposes of the state or a political subdivision of the
14	state, and for purposes of the federal government, or any official
15	of this state, a political subdivision of this state, or of the
16	federal government, in the same manner as a driver's license or a
17	personal identification card issued by the Department of Public
18	Safety.

10	of Origin issued by a court under this chapter by an individual to a

14	the permanent records of the agency.
