- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 17.16(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A surety may before forfeiture relieve the surety
- 7 [himself] of the surety's [his] undertaking by:
- 8 (1) surrendering the accused into the custody of the
- 9 sheriff of the county where the prosecution is pending; or
- 10 (2) delivering to the sheriff of the county where the
- 11 prosecution is pending an affidavit stating that the accused is
- 12 incarcerated in that jurisdiction [federal custody, in the custody
- 13 of any state, or in any county of this state].
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Article
- 15 17.16(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, applies only to a bail bond
- 16 that is executed on or after the effective date of this Act. A bail
- 17 bond executed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 18 the law in effect when the bail bond was executed, and the former
- 19 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
