3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 211 Section 211.002, Property Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 211.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. (a) This chapter
7	applies only to a residential real estate subdivision or any unit or
8	parcel of a subdivision located in whole or in part within an
9	unincorporated area of a county if the county has a population of
10	less than 65,000.

- 11 (b) This chapter applies only to restrictions that affect 12 real property within a residential real estate subdivision or any 13 units or parcels of the subdivision and that, by the express terms 14 of the instrument creating the restrictions:
- 15 (1) are not subject to a procedure by which the 16 restrictions may be amended; or
- 17 (2) may not be amended without the unanimous consent 18 of:
- 19 (A) all property owners in the subdivision; or
- 20 (B) all property owners in any unity or parcel of
- 21 the subdivision.
- 22 (3) a majority or more of the owners in the subdivision
- 23 with all sections of the subdivision collectively having more than
- 24 one hundred lots or tracts, with fifty percent or more of the lots

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- 1 being unimproved or owned by an absent owner. A lot shall be
- 2 considered unimproved if there is no residence constructed thereon,
- 3 and "absent owner" means a person or persons who do not reside in
- 4 the subdivision.
- 5 (c) This chapter applies to a restriction regardless of the
- 6 date on which it was created.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III. Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
