A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the transfer of title to a decedent's homestead through 1-8 1-9 a small estate affidavit.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 1-11 SECTION 1. Section 137(c), Texas Probate Code, is amended 1-12 to read as follows:

(c) 1-13 Title to a decedent's homestead that is the only real property in the [a] decedent's estate may be transferred on an 1-14 affidavit that meets the requirements of this section only to a distributee who is the decedent's child or who occupied the 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 property as the distributee's principal residence on the date of the decedent's death, provided that the distributee is otherwise 1-18 entitled to the property. An affidavit that is used to transfer title to a homestead under this section must be recorded in the deed 1-19 1-20 1-21 records of a county in which the homestead is located. A bona fide purchaser for value may rely on a recorded affidavit under this 1-22 section. A bona fide purchaser for value without actual or constructive notice of an heir who is not disclosed in a recorded 1-23 1-24 1**-**25 1**-**26 affidavit under this section acquires title to a homestead free of the interests of the undisclosed heir, but the bona fide purchaser remains subject to any claim a creditor of the decedent has by law. 1-27 1-28 A purchaser has constructive notice of an heir who is not disclosed 1-29 in a recorded affidavit under this section if an affidavit, 1-30 judgment of heirship, or title transaction in the chain of title in 1-31 the deed records identifies the heir of the decedent who is not 1-32 disclosed in the affidavit as an heir of the decedent. An heir who 1-33 is not disclosed in a recorded affidavit under this section may 1-34 recover from an heir who receives consideration from a purchaser in 1-35 a transfer for value of title to a homestead passing under the 1-36 affidavit.

1-37 SECTION 2. Section 137(c), Texas Probate Code, as amended by this Act, applies to the estate of a decedent that is pending on 1-38 or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of the 1-39 1-40 decedent's date of death. 1-41

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
