The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 3 4 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 5 6 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 7 8 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 9
