- 7 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the [The] commission may not prohibit or limit the idling of \underline{any} [\underline{a}] motor 8 9 vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8,500 pounds that is equipped with a 2008 or subsequent model year 10 heavy-duty diesel engine that has been certified by the United 11 12 States Environmental Protection Agency or another state environmental agency to emit no more than 30 grams of nitrogen 13 14 oxides per hour when idling [is necessary to power a heater or air conditioner while a driver is using the vehicle's sleeper berth for 15 a government-mandated rest period. Idling is not necessary to 16 power a heater or air conditioner if the vehicle is within two miles 17 of a facility offering external heating and air conditioning 18
- 20 (b-1) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, a
 21 vehicle is not subject to idling restrictions if the primary
 22 propulsion engine is being used to power a mechanical operation
 23 used to perform essential functions related to electric utility

- 4 IDLE REDUCTION SYSTEMS. (a) For purposes of this section, "idle
- 5 reduction system" means a system that provides heating, cooling, or
