- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 161.0541 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 161.0541. ELK DISEASE SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM. (a) The
- 8 <u>commission by rule may establish a disease surveillance program for</u>
- 9 elk.

- 10 (b) Rules adopted under this section must:
- 11 (1) require each person who moves elk in this state to
- 12 have elk tested for chronic wasting disease or other diseases as
- 13 <u>determined by the commission;</u>
- 14 (2) be designed to protect the health of the elk
- 15 population in this state; and
- 16 (3) include provisions for testing, identification,
- 17 transportation, and inspection under the disease surveillance
- 18 program.
- (c) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 20 violates a rule adopted by the commission under this section.
- 21 (d) An offense under Subsection (c) is a Class C misdemeanor
- 22 unless it is shown on the trial of the offense that the defendant
- 23 has previously been convicted of an offense under that subsection,
- 24 in which event the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.
