- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 161.0541 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 161.0541. ELK DISEASE SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM. (a) The
- 7 commission by rule may establish a disease surveillance program for
- 8 elk.
- 9 (b) Rules adopted under this section must:
- 10 (1) require each person who moves elk in this state to
- 11 have elk tested for chronic wasting disease or other diseases as
- 12 <u>determined by the commission;</u>
- 13 (2) be designed to protect the health of the elk
- 14 population in this state; and
- 15 (3) include provisions for testing, identification,
- 16 transportation, and inspection under the disease surveillance
- 17 program.
- 18 <u>(c) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly</u>
- 19 violates a rule adopted by the commission under this section.
- 20 <u>(d) An offense under Subsection (c) is a Class C misdemeanor</u>
- 21 unless it is shown on the trial of the offense that the defendant
- 22 has previously been convicted of an offense under that subsection,
- 23 in which event the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
