## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to elk participating in a disease surveillance program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 6, Agriculture Code,
- 5 Subchapter C, Chapter 161, is amended by adding Section 161.0541
- 6 Section 161.0541 (a) Elk, being moved in commerce, in Texas, shall
- 7 participate in a disease testing surveillance program administered
- 8 by the Commission.
- 9 (b) Any person who possess and transports elk within the
- 10 state shall test elk for CWD or other diseases as determined in
- 11 accordance with standards established by the Commission.
- 12 <u>(c)</u> The commission shall adopt rules to administer this
- 13 section, including rules relating to the testing, identification,
- 14 transportation, and inspection for participants in the disease
- 15 testing program.
- 16 (d) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 17 <u>fails to handle elk, in accordance with rules adopted</u> by the
- 18 <u>Commission</u>.
- (e) An offense under Subsection (d) of this section is a
- 20 Class C misdemeanor unless it is shown on the trial of the offense
- 21 that the defendant has been previously convicted under this
- 22 section, in which event the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
