A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the conveyance of certain state forest land in Cherokee
- 3 County under the control of the board of regents of The Texas A&M
- 4 University System.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE BY THE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.
- 7 The board of regents of The Texas A&M University System may convey
- 8 the following described real property:
- 9 BEING 221.64 acres of land in the J. S. EVANS SURVEY, ABSTRACT
- 10 No. 266, CHEROKEE COUNTY, TEXAS, and being the same land described
- 11 in Tract 1 and called 220 acres from the Texas State Hospitals &
- 12 Special School to the Texas Forest Service on September 3, 1963 and
- 13 recorded in Volume 541, Page 557 of the Deed Records of Cherokee
- 14 County, Texas (hereinafter shown as volume/page, DR, OR for
- 15 Official Records, LR for Land Records): SAID tract described as
- 16 follows:
- 17 BEARINGS are based on South 89°19' East between the 2" iron pipe
- 18 found at the Southwest corner of the J. S. EVANS and an axle found at
- 19 the Northeast corner of the A. W. CLARK SURVEY, ABSTRACT No. 1054,

- 5 THENCE North 89°13'33" West, with the South line of said 220 acres

- 7 at 480.42 feet pass the Northwest corner of said 30.78 acres and the
- 8 Northeast corner of that Undivided interest in 30.78 acres from
- 9 Thomas R. Sword to Harold E. Sword on December 16, 2005 in 1705/183,
- 10 OR, at 1815.48 feet pass a 1/2" steel rod found on the East bank of
- 11 Bull Creek for reference, at 1865.48 feet pass the center of Bull
- 12 Creek for the Northwest corner of said 30.78 acres and the Northeast
- 13 corner of that 62.26 acres from Mary Hampton to Rodney and Cathy

- 2 line, 851.54 feet to a 2" iron pipe found for an "ELL" corner of said
- 3 220 acres and said EVANS SURVEY, an "ELL" corner of said 110 acres
- 4 and said LUSK SURVEY, and in the South line of said 320 acres and
- 5 said RAINES SURVEY, from which found "X" on the face of a 20" Red Oak
- 6 North 86° West, 17.6 feet, a 10" Pine North 06° East, 29.8 feet, a
- 7 3/4" iron pipe found for reference is South 89°07' East, 42.01 feet,
- 8 and a 1/2" iron pipe found for reference is South $01^{\circ}08$ ' West, 41.12
- 9 feet;
- 10 THENCE South $89^{\circ}30'02"$ East, with an interior line of said 220 acres
- 11 and said EVANS SURVEY, and the South line of said 320 acres and said
- 12 RAINES SURVEY, and along a red painted hack and blazed line, 1943.20
- 13 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, and containing within these calls,
- 14 221.64 acres of land. This tract has no access to a public road.
- 15 SECTION 2. INTERESTS CONVEYED. The conveyance authorized
- 16 by this Act shall be of fee title to the surface and is exclusive of
- 17 all mineral rights. All instruments of conveyance shall be in a
- 18 form acceptable to The Texas A&M University System.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
