- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 392, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 392.067 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 392.067. VETERANS HOUSING IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) In
- 8 this section, "veteran" means a person who has served on active duty
- 9 in the armed forces of the United States or in the state military
- 10 forces as defined by Section 431.001, Government Code.
- 11 (b) A county or municipal housing authority in a county with
- 12 <u>a population of more than one million may borrow money, accept</u>
- 13 grants, and exercise its powers to provide safe and sanitary
- 14 housing communities for veterans.
- 15 (c) As the authority considers necessary to achieve the
- 16 purposes of this chapter, an authority may enter into a lease or
- 17 purchase agreement or accept a conveyance regarding real property
- 18 as part of a housing project that will benefit veterans. The
- 19 agreement or conveyance may include any restrictive covenants that
- 20 the authority considers appropriate regarding the property. As the
- 21 authority considers necessary and on the stipulation of the
- 22 parties, the covenants run with the property.
- 23 (d) A county or municipal housing authority to which this
- 24 section applies is not subject to the limitations in Section

- 1 392.014, 392.015, or 392.017 with respect to a housing project that
- 2 <u>benefits veterans as authorized by this section.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
