- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 392, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 392.067 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 392.067. VETERANS HOUSING IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) In
- 8 this section, "veteran" means a person who has served on active duty
- 9 in the armed forces of the United States or in the state military
- 10 forces as defined by Section 431.001, Government Code.
- 11 (b) A county or municipal housing authority in a county with
- 12 <u>a population of more than one million may borrow money, accept</u>
- 13 grants, and exercise its powers to provide safe and sanitary
- 14 housing for veterans who are persons of low income.
- 15 (c) As the authority considers necessary to achieve the
- 16 purposes of this chapter, an authority may enter into a lease or
- 17 purchase agreement or accept a conveyance regarding real property
- 18 as part of a housing project that will benefit veterans who are
- 19 persons of low income. The agreement or conveyance may include any
- 20 restrictive covenants that the authority considers appropriate
- 21 regarding the property. As the authority considers necessary and
- 22 on the stipulation of the parties, the covenants run with the
- 23 property.
- 24 (d) A veteran who is a person of low income and who is in

- 1 need of safe and sanitary housing may file an application with a
- 2 county or municipal housing authority to which this section applies
- 3 requesting that the authority provide safe and sanitary housing for
- 4 the veteran. The housing authority shall consider the application
- 5 in connection with the development of projects or programs to
- 6 provide housing for a veteran described by this section.
- 7 (e) A county or municipal housing authority to which this
- 8 section applies is not subject to the limitations in Section
- 9 <u>392.014</u>, <u>392.015</u>, or <u>392.017</u> with respect to a housing project that
- 10 benefits veterans as authorized by this section.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
