13	affiliates and subsidiaries, as those terms are defined by Section
14	823.003, issued property and casualty insurance policies in this
15	state that accounted for at least 10 percent of the total amount of
16	premiums collected by insurers for property and casualty insurance
17	in this state in the calendar year preceding the date the filing is
18	required or the rate is otherwise proposed to be used; and
19	(2) the proposed rate is seven percent or more than the
20	rate in effect on the date of the filing.

- 10 for residential property insurance delivered, issued for delivery,
- 11 or renewed before January 1, 2010, are governed by the law as it
- 12 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
