1 AN ACT 2 relating to the transfer of the powers, duties, and programs of the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation to the Texas Department 3 of Housing and Community Affairs and to the establishment of 4 5 certain other programs and divisions within the department. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2306.058 to read as follows: 8 9 Sec. 2306.058. TRANSITION PLAN FOR CERTAIN POWERS, DUTIES, AND PROGRAMS; RULES. (a) The director by rule shall adopt a 10 transition plan for the department's assumption of the former 11 powers and duties of the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation 12 under Section 2306.551. The transition plan must: 13 14 (1) include a timetable with specific steps and deadlines needed to fully complete the transfer; 15 (2) ensure that the programs administered under 16 Sections 2306.562 and 2306.5621 will be administered by a 17 tax-exempt organization listed under Section 501(c)(3), Internal 18 Revenue Code of 1986; and 19 20 (3) ensure that the transfer is fully implemented not 21 later than January 1, 2010. (b) The director may adopt rules necessary to improve the 22 23 efficiency or effectiveness of any program that is transferred to the department as a result of the department's assumption of the 24

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former powers and duties of the Texas State Affordable Housing 1 Corporation under Section 2306.551, including rules that provide 2 3 for consolidating the operation of programs already administered by the department and a program or programs that are transferred to the 4 5 department from the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation. 6 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the director may not 7 consolidate or eliminate the programs administered under Sections 8 2306.562 and 2306.5621. SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is 9 10 amended by adding Section 2306.084 to read as follows: Sec. 2306.084. NONPROFIT ASSISTANCE DIVISION. (a) 11 The 12 nonprofit assistance division is an independent entity within the department, is administratively attached to the department, and is 13 14 not an advisory body to the department. 15 (b) The department shall administer and enforce Section 2306.5552 through the nonprofit assistance division. 16 17 SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2306.095 to read as follows: 18 19 Sec. 2306.095. HOMELESS GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The department shall provide grants, supportive housing services, and housing 20 retention services to support services offered to homeless persons 21 by political subdivisions, housing finance corporations, 22 for-profit corporations, and nonprofit organizations. 23 24 (b) Grants made under this section must be used only for support services for homeless persons, including: 25 26 (1) case management;

5 SECTION 5. Section 2306.557, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

Sec. 2306.557. DISTRIBUTION OF EARNINGS. (a) Any part of 7 8 earnings remaining after payment of expenses and any establishment of reserves by the corporation's board of directors may not inure to 9 10 any person except that the corporation shall use these excess earnings to further the corporation's new or existing affordable 11 housing initiatives if the corporation's board of directors 12 determines that sufficient provision has been made for the full 13 payment of the expenses, bonds, and other obligations of the 14 15 corporation and for any establishment of reserves by the corporation's board of directors. 16

17 (b) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, all 18 earnings from bonds issued under Section 2306.5551, 2306.562, 19 2306.5621, or 2306.565 shall be allocated to the homeless grant 20 program under Section 2306.095.

21 SECTION 6. Sections 2306.255(g) and 2306.552, Government 22 Code, are repealed.

23 SECTION 7. (a) The Texas State Affordable Housing
24 Corporation is abolished on January 1, 2010.

(b) All powers, duties, obligations, rights, contracts,
funds, unspent appropriations, records, and real or personal
property of the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation shall be

3 (c) The nonprofit assistance division of the Texas 4 Department of Housing and Community Affairs created under Section 5 2306.084, Government Code, as added by this Act, is established on 6 the effective date of this Act.

A policy, procedure, or decision of the Texas State 7 (d) 8 Affordable Housing Corporation relating to a duty of that corporation that is transferred to the authority of the Texas 9 10 Department of Housing and Community Affairs under Section 2306.551, Government Code, as amended by this Act, continues in effect as a 11 12 policy, procedure, or decision of the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs until superseded by an act of the director of 13 14 the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.

(e) Except as otherwise provided by this Act, the validity of a plan or procedure adopted, contract or acquisition made, proceeding begun, grant or loan awarded, obligation incurred, right accrued, or other action taken by or in connection with the authority of the Texas State Affordable Housing Corporation before that corporation is abolished under Subsection (a) of this section is not affected by the abolishment.

(f) The director of the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs shall adopt rules relating to the transfer of the programs assigned to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs under Section 2306.551, Government Code, as amended by this Act, not later than October 1, 2009.

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SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
