- 8 contract for the construction of a new home or an improvement to an
- 9 existing home required to be registered under Section 426.003, the
- 10 contract is not enforceable against a homeowner unless the
- 11 contract:
- 12 (1) contains the builder's name and certificate of 13 registration number; and
- 14 (2) contains the notice required by Section 420.001.
- (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a builder's failure to
- 16 comply with that subsection does not invalidate a lien of an entity
- 17 that:
- (1) provided third-party financing to a homeowner for
- 19 the construction of a new home or an improvement to an existing home
- 20 under a residential construction contract; or
- 21 (2) renewed and extended financing for a purpose
- 22 <u>described by Subdivision (1).</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
