## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 92.025 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 92.025. TENANT'S REMEDIES REGARDING GOVERNMENTAL
8	DETERMINATION OF SUBSTANDARD HOUSING. If a municipality or a
9	county revokes a certificate of occupancy for a leased premises
10	because of the landlord's failure to maintain the premises, the
11	landlord is liable to a tenant who is not in default under the lease
12	<pre>for:</pre>
13	(1) the full amount of the tenant's security deposit;
14	(2) the pro rata portion of any rental payment the
15	tenant has paid in advance;
16	(3) the tenant's actual damages, including any moving
17	costs, utility connection fees, storage fees, and lost wages; and
18	(4) court costs and attorney's fees arising from any
19	related cause of action by the tenant against the landlord.
20	SECTION 2. The changes in the law made by this Act apply

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only to a lease entered into on or after September 1, 2009. A lease

entered into before September 1, 2009, is governed by the law as it

existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that

law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
