- 2 relating to the registration of individuals who assist in certain
- 3 early voting procedures; providing a criminal penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 86.010(a) and (e), Election Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A voter casting a ballot by mail who would be eligible
- 8 under Section 64.031 to receive assistance at a polling place may
- 9 select a person as provided by Section 64.032(c) or a person who is
- 10 registered under Section 86.015 to assist the voter in preparing
- 11 the ballot.
- 12 (e) A person who assists a voter to prepare a ballot to be
- 13 voted by mail shall enter the person's signature, printed name,
- 14 telephone number, and residence address on the official carrier
- 15 envelope of the voter.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 86, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 17 Section 86.015 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 86.015. EARLY VOTING ASSISTANT REGISTRATION. (a) A
- 19 person who assists more than five voters in an election with the
- 20 preparation of their ballots under this chapter must register as an
- 21 <u>early voting assistant.</u>
- 22 (b) The secretary of state shall prescribe an early voting
- 23 <u>assistant registration form. The form must include:</u>
- 24 (1) a space for the person's name, signature, address,

- 1 telephone number, and voter registration number and the date of
- 2 signing;
- 3 (2) the oath prescribed by Section 64.034; and
- 4 (3) a space for the person to indicate whether the
- 5 person has ever been convicted of an offense in connection with
- 6 conduct directly attributable to an election.
- 7 (c) Each person required to register under this section
- 8 shall file the form required by Subsection (b) with the early voting
- 9 clerk. A registration filed under this section expires on December
- 10 31 of each odd-numbered year.
- 11 (d) The early voting clerk shall maintain current
- 12 registrations in a file that is available to the public for
- 13 inspection.
- (e) Subsection (a) does not apply if the person assisting a
- 15 voter is:
- 16 (1) related to the voter within the second degree by
- 17 affinity or the third degree by consanguinity, as determined under
- 18 Subchapter B, Chapter 573, Government Code;
- 19 (2) registered to vote at the same address as the
- 20 voter;
- 21 (3) employed by the nursing home or other long-term
- 22 care facility or retirement center in which the voter resides;
- 23 (4) employed by the hospital in which the voter is a
- 24 patient at the time the assistance is provided; or
- 25 (5) an early voting clerk or deputy early voting
- 26 clerk.
- 27 (f) A person is ineligible for registration under this

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- 1 section if the person has been finally convicted of an offense in
- 2 <u>connection with conduct directly attributable to an election.</u>
- 3 (g) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 4 violates Subsection (a). An offense under this subsection is a
- 5 Class A misdemeanor.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2010.
