## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the requirements for a petition proposing an amendment
- 3 to the charter of a home-rule municipality.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9.004(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing body of a municipality on its own motion
- 8 may submit a proposed charter amendment to the municipality's
- 9 qualified voters for their approval at an election. The governing
- 10 body shall submit a proposed charter amendment to the voters for
- 11 their approval at an election if the submission is supported by a
- 12 petition signed by a number of <u>registered</u> [qualified] voters of the
- 13 municipality equal to at least 10 [five] percent of the number of
- 14 registered [qualified] voters of the municipality [or 20,000,
- 15 whichever number is the smaller]. The petition requirements of
- 16 this subsection do not affect a petition submitted under Chapter
- 17 <u>143 or 174.</u>
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to a petition proposing a charter amendment that is filed with a
- 20 municipality on or after September 1, 2009.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
