- 2 relating to certain illegal pricing practices.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 552.003(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A person commits an offense if:
- 7 (1) the person knowingly or intentionally charges two
- 8 different prices, including contractual allowances, for providing
- 9 the same product or service; and
- 10 (2) the higher price charged, including contractual
- 11 allowances, is based on the fact that an insurer or its insured will
- 12 pay all or part of the price of the product or service.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 governed by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed,
- $\,$ 17 $\,$ and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the
- 18 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 19 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 20 before that date.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
