A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the procedures for certain honorably retired peace
- 3 officers to maintain a license to carry a concealed handgun.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 411.199(a) and (e), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person who is licensed as a peace officer under
- 8 Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, [Chapter 415] and who has been
- 9 employed full-time as a peace officer by a law enforcement agency
- 10 may apply for a license under this subchapter at any time after
- 11 retirement.
- 12 (e) A retired peace officer who obtains a license under this
- 13 subchapter must maintain, for the category of weapon licensed, the
- 14 proficiency required for a peace officer under Section 1701.355,
- 15 Occupations Code [Section 415.035]. The department [or a local law
- 16 enforcement agency] shall allow a retired peace officer of the
- 17 department $[\frac{\text{or agency}}{\text{an opportunity to annually demonstrate the}}]$
- 18 required proficiency. A local law enforcement agency shall allow a
- 19 retired peace officer of the agency, or a retired peace officer who
- 20 resides in the jurisdiction of the agency, an opportunity to
- 21 annually demonstrate the required proficiency. The proficiency
- 22 shall be reported to the department on application and renewal.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
