A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 548.405, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsections (h) and (i) and adding Subsections (j) and
- 8 (k) to read as follows:
- 9 (h) The department shall develop [, by September 1, 2002,] a
- 10 penalty schedule consisting of warnings, re-education,
- 11 <u>administrative penalties</u>, suspensions, and revocations based on
- 12 the severity and frequency of offenses committed under this chapter
- 13 [Chapter 548, Transportation Code,] and rules adopted by the
- 14 department under this chapter.
- 15 (i) The department shall develop $[\frac{1}{2}, \frac{1}{2}]$ a
- 16 penalty schedule consisting of administrative penalties,
- 17 suspensions, and revocations based on the severity and frequency of
- 18 offenses committed in the emissions testing of motor vehicles under
- 19 Section 382.202, Health and Safety Code, and Chapter 548,
- 20 Subchapter F, of this code.
- 21 (j) As an alternative to the suspension or revocation of the
- 22 <u>certificate of a person, inspection station, or inspector under</u>
- 23 this section, the department may impose an administrative penalty
- 24 on the person, inspection station, or inspector.

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- 1 (k) The amount of an administrative penalty imposed under
 2 Subsection (j) may not exceed \$1,000 for each act that constitutes
 3 grounds for imposition of the penalty. A separate penalty may be
 4 imposed for each day that an act that constitutes grounds for
 5 imposition of the penalty continues. The aggregate amount of
 6 separate penalties on a person, inspection station, or inspector
- 7 may not exceed \$10,000.
- SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Public Safety shall develop the penalty schedules required by Sections 548.405(h) and (i), Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, not later than October 1, 2009.
- SECTION 3. Section 548.405, Transportation Code, as amended 12 by this Act, applies only to the suspension or revocation of the 13 14 certificate of a person, inspection station, or inspector under that section, or the imposition of an administrative penalty on 15 that person, inspection station, or inspector, for conduct 16 17 committed on or after the effective date of this Act. A revocation or suspension of an inspection station certificate or an inspector 18 certificate for conduct committed before the effective date of this 19 Act is covered by the law in effect on the date the conduct was 20 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 21 22 purpose.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
