4	SECTION 1. Section 2054.126(d), Government Code, is amended

7	education, that receives an aggregate amount of appropriations in
8	the General Appropriations Act for a state fiscal biennium that
9	exceeds \$175 million shall post the following information during
10	the biennium on a generally accessible Internet site maintained by
11	or for the agency:
12	(6) an electronic link on the agency Internet site's

14	(A) the provisions of the Texas Constitution as
15	published in the electronic version of the constitution hosted by
16	the Texas Legislative Council that authorize, govern, control, or

- 2 the Texas Administrative Code.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
