- 2 relating to a legislative outreach program requiring members of the
- 3 State Board of Education to visit public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 7.117 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 7.117. BACK-TO-SCHOOL PROGRAM. (a) The board shall
- 8 establish a program under which members of the board visit public
- 9 schools in their districts. The board shall provide board members
- 10 with the resources necessary to enable each member to effectively
- 11 participate in the program.
- 12 (b) Under the program, each board member must visit at least
- 13 three public schools in the member's district during each school
- 14 year. To the extent practicable, during that period a board member
- 15 shall visit at least one public school in each accreditation status
- 16 recognized by the commissioner. Each visit must be planned in
- 17 <u>advance with the participating school and must include one or more</u>
- 18 opportunities for the board member to interact with students in
- 19 discussions or activities.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
