4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 303, Business & Commerce
6	Code, as effective April 1, 2009, is amended by adding Sections
7	303.105-303.107 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 303.105. REQUIRED DISCLOSURES. A commercial telephone
9	solicitor may not make a telephone solicitation call unless the
10	solicitor makes the following disclosures during the call using
11	substantially the following language:
12	(1) "You will not receive any preferential treatment
13	by any law enforcement officer or organization if you make a
14	<pre>contribution"; and</pre>
15	(2) "It is a criminal act for any law enforcement
16	officer to provide you with preferential treatment because you have
17	made a contribution."
18	Sec. 303.106. RECORDING OF CALLS. A commercial telephone
19	solicitor shall:
20	(1) record each telephone solicitation call and retain
21	the recording until the 31st day after the date the call was
22	recorded; and
23	(2) allow the attorney general access to the recording
24	for review at the attorney general's discretion.

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1	Sec. 303.107. USE OF MONEY FOR NONCHARITABLE PURPOSE. A law
2	enforcement-related charitable organization that uses any of the
3	money it receives through telephone solicitation for a
4	noncharitable purpose must ensure that any commercial telephone
5	solicitor that it retains to make telephone solicitations complies
6	with the Texas no-call list established under Subchapter B, Chapter
7	<u>304.</u>
8	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
9	a telephone solicitation made on or after the effective date of this
10	Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
