8	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is
9	amended by adding Section 2306.189 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 2306.189. DUTY TO REPORT TO UNITED STATES CENSUS
11	BUREAU. (a) In this section, "multiunit residential property" has
12	the meaning assigned by Section 125.001, Civil Practice and
13	Remedies Code.
14	(b) The department shall determine the occupancy of
15	multiunit residential properties in this state and annually forward
16	that information to the United States Census Bureau.
17	(c) In determining the occupancy of multiunit residential
18	properties, the department must collect the following information
19	for each census tract in this state:
20	(1) the number of units in each multiunit residential
21	property; and
22	(2) the number of occupants in each unit of a multiunit
23	residential property.
24	(d) The department may send other statistical information

1 to the United States Census Bureau if the department determines the 2 information will assist the bureau in conducting a census.

3 (e) The owner of a multiunit residential property must
4 submit to the department the information required by Subsection (c)
5 and other information requested by the department.

6 (f) The department shall adopt rules as necessary to 7 implement this section.

8 SECTION 2. Subchapter DD, Chapter 2306, Government Code, is 9 amended by adding Section 2306.6736 to read as follows:

10 <u>Sec. 2306.6736. REQUIREMENT TO REPORT CERTAIN CENSUS</u> 11 <u>INFORMATION. The department by rule may require an applicant to</u> 12 <u>provide information relating to the number of units and the</u> 13 <u>occupancy of each unit in a housing development as a condition of</u> 14 <u>receiving or retaining a housing tax credit under this chapter.</u>

15 SECTION 3. The Texas Department of Housing and Community 16 Affairs shall develop the method for collecting information 17 relating to the occupancy of multiunit residential properties as 18 required by Section 2306.189, Government Code, as added by this 19 Act, not later than January 1, 2010.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
