## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 154, Finance Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 154.265 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 154.265. DEFAULT UNDER CERTAIN CONTRACTS. (a)
- 7 Notwithstanding any other law, the purchaser of a trust-funded
- 8 prepaid funeral benefits contract may not be considered in default
- 9 under the contract if the purchaser has paid at least 85 percent of
- 10 the contract price.
- 11 (b) A funeral provider is not required to provide funeral
- 12 merchandise or services under a trust-funded prepaid funeral
- 13 benefits contract unless any remaining balance, including any
- 14 applicable finance charge, owed under the contract is paid before
- 15 the funeral service or the funeral provider agrees in writing to
- 16 another payment arrangement.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> This section does not affect a purchaser's right to
- 18 cancel a trust-funded prepaid funeral benefits contract.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to a contract that is entered into on or after the effective date of
- 21 this Act. A contract entered into before the effective date of this
- 22 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was
- 23 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 24 purpose.
