A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of certain regional planning 3 commissions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 391.003, Local Government Code, is 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 7 read as follows:

8 (a) <u>Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), any</u> [Any] 9 combination of counties or municipalities or of counties and 10 municipalities may agree, by ordinance, resolution, rule, order, or 11 other means, to establish a commission.

12 (a-1) A county with a population of 240,000 or more that 13 borders the Gulf of Mexico may agree to establish a commission as 14 provided by Subsection (a) only with:

15 (1) counties with a population of less than 3.3
16 million that are located within 100 miles of the Gulf of Mexico;

17 (2) municipalities located wholly within a county 18 described by Subdivision (1); or

19(3) counties and municipalities described by20Subdivisions (1) and (2).

21 SECTION 2. Not later than November 1, 2009, any county 22 described by Section 391.003(a-1), Local Government Code, as added 23 by this Act, participating in a regional planning commission that 24 does not comply with Section 391.003(a-1), Local Government Code,

1 as added by this Act, shall withdraw from the commission.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
