A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

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1-8 relating the evaluation of certain regional planning to 1-9 commissions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Before June 1, 2010, the state auditor shall audit a regional planning commission created under Chapter 391, Local Government Code, that includes a county with a population of 3.3 million or more, according to the most recent federal decennial census. The cost of the audit shall be paid for by the regional planning commission.

- (b) On or before June 1, 2010, the state auditor shall submit a report of an audit conducted under Subsection (a) of this section to:
- (1) the commissioners court of a county with a population of 240,000 or more, according to the most recent federal decennial census, that borders the Gulf of Mexico and is a member of a regional planning commission described by Subsection (a) of this section; and
- (2) the governing body of any other political subdivision that is a member of a regional planning commission described by Subsection (a) of this section, if the governing body requests a report from the state auditor.
 - (c) This section expires January 1, 2011.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-30 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-32 1-33 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-34 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
