1 (2) a permit with an extended duration. 2 (e) The Parks and Wildlife Commission and the Texas Animal Health Commission may adopt rules to implement this section. 3 4 SECTION 2. The Parks and Wildlife Department and the Texas Animal Health Commission shall develop a preliminary version of the 5 6 deer breeder database required by this Act not later than June 1, 7 2010. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 12
