- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.002(n), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (n) The State Board of Education \underline{shall} [\underline{may}] by rule
- 9 develop and implement a plan designed to incorporate foundation
- 10 curriculum requirements into the career and technology education
- 11 curriculum under Subsection (a)(2)(F). <u>In developing and</u>
- 12 implementing the plan, the board shall ensure that the career and
- 13 <u>technology education curriculum is provided as an optional</u>
- 14 supplement for students instead of as a substitute for foundation
- 15 curriculum classes designed to prepare a student for postsecondary
- 16 education.
- SECTION 2. Section 29.183, Education Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 19 (d) Career and technology classes may not be offered as a
- 20 substitute for academic classes designed to prepare a student for
- 21 <u>postsecondary educati</u>on.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2010-2011
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
