2	relating to the creation of a comprehensive emissions database.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 382.014, Health and
5	Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
6	ELECTRONIC EMISSION INVENTORY DATABASE
7	SECTION 2. Section 382.014, Health and Safety Code, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	(a) The commission shall develop a single, comprehensive
10	electronic database of all emissions that shall centrally track all
11	authorized and reported emissions activities and collect
12	information relating to:
13	(A) permitted emissions;
14	(B) annual routine emissions;
15	(C) excess emissions occurring during
16	maintenance activities, including startups and shutdowns; and
17	(D) and emissions resulting from emissions
18	events.
19	(b) The commission shall develop the capacity and shall
20	incorporate all authorized and reported emissions into a permanent
21	centralized database for emissions. The commission shall develop a
22	mechanism whereby the reporting entity shall be allowed to review
23	the information relative to its reported emissions prior to such
24	information being included in the database. The database shall be

- 1 accessible to the public.
- 2 (c) The commission annually shall assess the information
- 3 received under this section, including emissions, and shall include
- 4 the assessment in the report required by Section 5.126, Water Code.
- 5 <u>(d)</u> The commission may require a person whose activities
- 6 cause emissions of air contaminants to submit information to enable
- 7 the commission to develop an inventory of emissions of air
- 8 contaminants in this state.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
