18	(ii) a steering wheel used to maneuver the

20	(iii) a propulsion unit located in front of
21	or behind the enclosed occupant compartment;
22	(iv) a seat belt for each vehicle occupant
23	certified by the manufacturer to meet the requirements of Federal
24	Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 209, 49 C.F.R. Section 571.209;

H.B. No. 3599 1 (v) a windshield and one or more windshield wipers certified by the manufacturer to meet the requirements of 2 Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 205, 49 C.F.R. Section 3 571.205, and Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 104, 49 4 C.F.R. Section 571.104; and 5 6 (vi) a vehicle structure certified by the 7 vehicle manufacturer to meet the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 216, 49 C.F.R. Section 571.216; and 8 9 (E) is produced by its manufacturer in a minimum 10 quantity of 300 in any calendar year. 11 SECTION 2. Section 521.085, Transportation Code, is amended 12 to read as follows: Sec. 521.085. TYPE OF VEHICLE AUTHORIZED. 13 (a) Unless prohibited by Chapter 522, and except as provided by Subsection 14 (b), the license holder may operate any vehicle of the type for 15 which that class of license is issued and any lesser type of vehicle 16 other than a motorcycle or moped. 17 (b) Subsection (a) does not prohibit a license holder from 18 19 operating a lesser type of vehicle that is a motorcycle described by Section 521.001(a)(6-a). 20 21 SECTION 3. Section 661.001(1), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 22 (1) "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle designed to 23 propel itself with not more than three wheels in contact with the 24 ground, and having a saddle for the use of the rider. The term does 25 26 not include a tractor or a three-wheeled vehicle equipped with a cab or occupant compartment, seat, and seat belt and designed to 27

1 contain the operator in the cab or occupant compartment.

2 SECTION 4. Section 680.013, Transportation Code, is amended 3 to read as follows:

Sec. 680.013. USE OF PREFERENTIAL LANE BY MOTORCYCLE. A
motorcycle, including a motorcycle described by Section
<u>521.001(a)(6-a)</u>, may be operated in a preferential lane that is not
closed to all vehicular traffic.
