- 16 which that class of license is issued and any lesser type of vehicle

- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 680.013. USE OF PREFERENTIAL LANE BY MOTORCYCLE. A
- 5 motorcycle, including a motorcycle described by Section
- 6 521.001(a)(6-a), may be operated in a preferential lane that is not
- 7 closed to all vehicular traffic.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
