6	82.005, Local Government Code, are designated as Subchapter A,
7	Chapter 82, Local Government Code, and a heading is added to

10	SECTION 2. Chapter 82, Local Government Code, is amended by
11	adding Subchapter B to read as follows:
12	SUBCHAPTER B. MISCELLANEOUS POWERS AND DUTIES
13	Sec. 82.051. ELECTRONIC DISPLAY OF OFFICIAL AND LEGAL
14	NOTICES BY COUNTY CLERK. (a) In this section, "electronic display"
15	includes a display by the use of an electronic kiosk, electronic
16	bulletin board, or other similar device designed to provide readily
17	accessible information.
18	(b) A county clerk may post an official and legal notice by
19	electronic display instead of posting a physical document. An
20	electronic display of information posted under this section must
21	meet the location, time, and accessibility requirements provided by
22	law for the posting of the notice.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
