H.B. No. 3630

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the minimum salary schedule for public school
3 employees.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, subsection (a), Education Code
6 is amended as follows:

7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), (e), or (f), a
8 school district must pay each classroom teacher, full-time
9 librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B,
10 educational diagnostician, speech pathologist or full-time school
11 nurse not less than the minimum monthly salary, based on the
12 employee's level of experience, determined by the following
13 formula:

$$MS = SF \times FS$$

15 where:

16 "MS" is the minimum monthly salary;

17 "SF" is the applicable salary factor specified by Subsection
18 (c); and

19 "FS" is the amount, as determined by the commissioner under
20 Subsection (b), of state and local funds per weighted student,
21 including funds provided under Section 42.2516(b)(1)(B), but not
22 funds provided under Section 42.2516(b)(1)(A), (b)(1)(C), (b)(2),
23 or (b)(3), available to a district eligible to receive state
24 assistance under Section 42.302 with a maintenance and operations

1 tax rate per \$100 of taxable value equal to the product of the state
2 compression percentage, as determined under Section 42.2516,
3 multiplied by \$1.50, except that the amount of state and local funds
4 per weighted student does not include the amount attributable to
5 the increase in the guaranteed level made by Chapter 1187, Acts of
6 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001.

7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
