| 14 | (c) For the purposes of this section lighting of state owned |
| 15 | parking facilities shall be construed as outdoor use. |
| 16 | (d) This Section applies only to the new installation of a |
| 17 | lamp or to the repair, renovation, or retrofit of a lamp no longer |
| 18 | properly functioning. |
| 19 | (e) An agency may choose to waive the provisions of |
