A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to creditable service in the Employees Retirement System
3 of Texas and the transfer of that credit between classes of
4 membership for certain state employees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 813.201, Government Code, is amended by
adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

8 (d) A person who is a member or retiree of the elected class 9 who served in the house of representatives of this state and who 10 holds a position as an employee of the house of representatives may 11 accrue service credit for that position only if the person is a 12 full-time employee. For purposes of this section, "full-time 13 employee" means an employee designated by the house of 14 representatives of this state as working 40 or more hours a week.

15 SECTION 2. Section 813.503, Government Code, is amended by 16 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 17 follows:

18 A member may establish in, or have transferred to, the (a) employee class all service credited in the elected class, if the 19 contributions made to establish the service in the elected class 20 21 equal or exceed contributions required of a member of the employee class for the same amount of service during the same time and at the 22 23 same rate of compensation. Subject to the requirements of Subsection (e), a [A] member or retiree who has, or had at the time 24

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1 of retirement, at least eight years of service credit in the elected class of membership, exclusive of military service, may transfer 2 3 service credit between classes before or after retirement.

4 (e) A person who is a member or retiree of the elected class who served in the house of representatives of this state may 5 transfer service credit between the employee class and the elected 6 class only if with respect to service credited in the employee class 7 8 the person provides documentation that the person performed the <u>servi</u>ce: 9

10 (1) as a full-time employee as that term is defined by Section 1551.003, Insurance Code; or 11

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(2) as an employee designated by the house of representatives as an employee working 40 or more hours a week. 13

14 SECTION 3. Section 813.201(d), Government Code, as added by 15 this Act, applies only to service credits accrued by a member of the Employees Retirement System of Texas for service performed on or 16 17 after the effective date of this Act. Service credits accrued for service performed before the effective date of this Act is governed 18 19 by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 20

SECTION 4. Section 813.503(e), Government Code, as added by 21 this Act, applies only to a transfer of service credits under 22 Section 813.503, as amended by this Act, by a member of the 23 24 Employees Retirement System of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act. A transfer that occurs before the effective date of 25 26 this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 27

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1 that purpose.

2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
