Section 113.085, Property Code, is amended by 4 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to 5 read as follows: 6 7 (c) A cotrustee shall participate in the performance of a trustee's function unless the cotrustee: 8 9 (1) is unavailable to perform the function because of absence, illness, suspension under this code, disqualification 10 under other law, or other temporary incapacity; or 11 12 (2) has delegated the performance of the function to 13 another trustee in accordance with the terms of the trust or applicable law, has communicated the delegation to all other 14 cotrustees, and has filed the delegation in the records of the 15 16 trust. (d) If a cotrustee is unavailable to participate in the 17 performance of a trustee's function for a reason described by 18 Subsection (c)(1) and prompt action is necessary to achieve the 19 efficient administration or purposes of the trust or to avoid 20 injury to the trust property or a beneficiary, the remaining 21 cotrustee or a majority of the remaining cotrustees may act for the 22 23 trust.

2	been suspended under this code, the remaining cotrustee or
3	cotrustees may act for the trust as provided by the order of the
4	court that suspended the cotrustee or another order of that court.
5	SECTION 2. Section 113.085, Property Code, as amended by
6	this Act, applies only to a trust existing on or after September 1,
7	2009, regardless of the date the trust was created.
8	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
