- 2 relating to administration of a trust involving cotrustees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 113.085, Property Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsections (b), (c), and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1)
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided in Subsection (c-1), if [H] a
- 8 vacancy, including a temporary vacancy due to the suspension of a
- 9 trustee, occurs in a cotrusteeship, the remaining cotrustees may
- 10 act for the trust.
- 11 (c) A cotrustee shall participate in the performance of a
- 12 trustee's function unless the cotrustee:
- 13 (1) is unavailable to perform the function because of
- 14 absence, illness, suspension by court order, disqualification
- 15 under other law, or other temporary incapacity; or
- 16 (2) has delegated the performance of the function to
- 17 another trustee in accordance with the terms of the trust or
- 18 applicable law, has communicated the delegation to all other
- 19 cotrustees, and has filed the delegation in the records of the
- 20 trust.
- 21 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a cotrustee who is a
- 22 beneficiary of the trust may not exercise sole discretion in taking
- 23 an action or making a decision regarding the trust if the action or
- 24 decision benefits the cotrustee as beneficiary.

- 1 (d) If a cotrustee is unavailable to participate in the
- 2 performance of a trustee's function for a reason described by
- 3 Subsection (c)(1) or (c-1) and performance of the trustee's
- 4 function [prompt action] is necessary to achieve the timely
- 5 administration [purposes] of the trust or to avoid injury to the
- 6 trust property, the remaining cotrustee or [a majority of] the
- 7 remaining cotrustees may act for the trust.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 113.085, Property Code, as amended by
- 9 this Act, applies only to a trust created on or after September 1,
- 10 2009. A trust created before September 1, 2009, is governed by the
- 11 law in effect on the date the trust was created, and the former law
- 12 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
