C.S.H.B. No. 3637 a fee that becomes payable on or after the effective date of this Act. A fee that becomes payable before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the fee became payable, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
