## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to eligibility of certain children for public school
- 3 prekindergarten classes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.153, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (f) and adding Subsection (a-1)
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) <u>In this section:</u>
  - (1) "Child" includes a stepchild.
- 10 (2) "Parent" includes a stepparent.
- 11 (a-1) A district shall offer prekindergarten classes if the
- 12 district identifies 15 or more children who are eligible under
- 13 Subsection (b) and are at least four years of age. A school
- 14 district may offer prekindergarten classes if the district
- 15 identifies 15 or more eligible children who are at least three years
- 16 of age. A district may not charge tuition for a prekindergarten
- 17 class offered under this section.
- 18 (b) A child is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten
- 19 class under this section if the child is at least three years of age
- 20 and:

- 21 (1) is unable to speak and comprehend the English
- 22 language;
- 23 (2) is educationally disadvantaged;
- 24 (3) is a homeless child, as defined by 42 U.S.C.

- 1 Section 11434a, regardless of the residence of the child, of either
- 2 parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person
- 3 having lawful control of the child;
- 4 (4) is the child of an active duty member of the armed
- 5 forces of the United States, including the state military forces or
- 6 a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active
- 7 duty by proper authority;
- 8 (5) is the child of a member of the armed forces of the
- 9 United States, including the state military forces or a reserve
- 10 component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while
- 11 serving on active duty; [or]
- 12 (6) is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the
- 13 Department of Family and Protective Services following an adversary
- 14 hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code; or
- 15 (7) is the child of a classroom teacher who teaches at
- 16 <u>a school in which at least 99 percent of the students are</u>
- 17 educationally disadvantaged.
- 18 (f) A child who is eligible for enrollment in a
- 19 prekindergarten class under Subsection (b)(4) or (5) remains
- 20 eligible for enrollment if the child's parent leaves the armed
- 21 forces, or is no longer on active duty, after the child begins a
- 22 prekindergarten class. A child who is eligible for enrollment in a
- 23 prekindergarten class under Subsection (b)(7) remains eligible for
- 24 enrollment if the child's parent ceases teaching at a school
- 25 described by Subsection (b)(7) after the child begins a
- 26 prekindergarten class.

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
