A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the protocol for certain do not resuscitate orders. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 166.101(a), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: the 6 (a) The board shall, on the recommendation of 7 department, adopt all reasonable and necessary rules to carry out 8 the purposes of this subchapter, including rules: 9 (1)adopting a statewide out-of-hospital DNR order protocol that sets out standard procedures for the withholding of 10 cardiopulmonary resuscitation and certain other life-sustaining 11 treatment by health care professionals acting in out-of-hospital 12 settings and includes the alternatives described in Section 13 14 166.082; 15 (2) designating life-sustaining treatment that may be included in an out-of-hospital DNR order, including all procedures 16 listed in Sections 166.081(6)(A)(i) through (v); 17 18 (3) explicitly specifying that an out-of-hospital DNR order may be issued by a physician only in compliance with a 19 directive or instruction issued in accordance with the alternatives 20 21 described in Section 166.082; 22 (4) explicitly specifying that DNR orders applicable 23 in hospitals may be issued only in compliance with: 24 (A) the directions of the patient if competent;

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(B) the directions in an advance directive in 1 2 accordance with Section 166.005 or 166.032; 3 (C) the directions of the patient's legal 4 guardian or agent under a medical power of attorney; 5 (D) a treatment decision in accordance with 6 Section 166.039; or 7 (E) a reasonable medical judgment by the attending physician that the patient's death is imminent within 8 9 minutes or hours even if cardiopulmonary resuscitation is provided; 10 and (5) [(3)] governing recordkeeping in circumstances in 11 which an out-of-hospital DNR order or DNR identification device is 12 encountered by responding health care professionals. 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 18

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
