- 10 (1) any property tax paying resident of the

- 12 (2) a person who submitted a bid for a contract for
- 13 which the competitive sealed bidding requirement applies,
- 14 regardless of residency, if the contract is for the construction of
- 15 public works.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a contract entered into on or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act. A contract entered into before the effective date of this Act
- 19 is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and
- 20 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
