## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the sovereign immunity of state military forces.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 101.054, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 101.054. STATE MILITARY PERSONNEL. This chapter does
- 7 not apply to a claim arising from the activities of the state
- 8 military forces [when on active duty under the lawful orders of
- 9 competent authority].
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 12 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 13 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 14 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 15 that purpose.

- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
