- 7 Sec. 22.042. CONTRIBUTING TO DELINQUENCY OF A CHILD. (a) A
- 8 person commits an offense if the person is 17 years of age or older
- 9 and intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causes or encourages a
- 10 child to:
- 11 (1) engage in specific conduct that, under the
- 12 circumstances surrounding the actor's conduct, would cause the
- 13 child to be present during the commission of an offense under
- 14 another section of this code; or
- 15 (2) enter or remain in a place where:
- 16 (A) a controlled substance, a controlled
- 17 substance analogue, drug paraphernalia, or marihuana, as defined by
- 18 Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, is used, possessed,
- 19 manufactured, or distributed; or
- 20 <u>(B) prostitution is practiced.</u>
- 21 (b) In this section, "child" means any person younger than
- 22 17 years of age.
- (c) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
- 24 degree if the actor commits the offense intentionally or knowingly.

- 2 <u>A misdemeanor.</u>
- 3 (d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 4 <u>also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the</u>

- 6 sections.
