## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to fees of office for directors of certain water

- 3 districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 49.060(a) and (a-1), Water Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A director is entitled to receive fees of office of not
- 8 more than  $\frac{$200}{}$  [ $\frac{$150}{}$ ] a day for each day the director actually
- 9 spends performing the duties of a director. In this subsection,
- 10 "performing the duties of a director" means substantive performance
- 11 of the management or business of the district, including
- 12 participation in board and committee meetings and other activities
- 13 involving the substantive deliberation of district business and in
- 14 pertinent educational programs. The phrase does not include
- 15 routine or ministerial activities such as the execution of
- 16 documents, self-preparation for meetings, or other activities
- 17 requiring a minimal amount of time.
- 18 (a-1) A district, by resolution of the board, shall set a
- 19 limit on the fees of office that a director may receive in a year.
- 20 Except for a district that is a special water authority engaged in
- 21 the distribution and sale of electric energy to the public, a
- 22 district may not set the annual limit at an amount greater than
- 23 \$9,600 [<del>\$7,200</del>].
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
